• 2020/21 Hockey Season

- 2020/21 Season Startup Issues/discussion
 - Facility Entry/Exit:
 - Now exiting out the back of the building during daylight. Lack of lighting at this doorway. Waiting until late November for lights to arrive. Late evening people will leave from entrance of building
 - People are encouraged to social distance in parking lot when waiting to enter
 - New protocol as of Saturday Nov.8 temperature monitoring prior to entering the facility. Arena staff to take the temperature of all entrants prior to entering the facility.
 - Temperature to be scanned via wrist, not forehead. Not supposed to be scanning kids <5 years.
 - Lack of communication from municipality, now being rectified with communication being dispersed in the coming days
 - Masks
 - Very few incidents of parents refusing to wear masks
 - Great job by parents and families
 - Capacity Limits and enforcement
 - Grey area with younger age groups. Maximum of 50
 participants inside the facility during ice times. 1 parent
 guardian per child, then a second child will be first priority
 - On Ice:

- Previous cap of 22 raised by municipality to 25. Only for additional coaches and assistants. Older groups will remain at 22.
- ACTION: Steve to check with Lisa L regarding referees and executive members as counting towards numbers
- Off Ice:
- Midget T2 Issues:
 - Just at facility for games one night /week
 - 3 teams in this group and no goalies
 - Invited tier 1 goalies to participate with tier 2 group, also done with Bantam group which changes the current bubble to 40 players limiting playing teams outside PEC.
 - ACTION item: Ben and Jason to discuss with coaches of U11 and under the possibility of changing bubbles to combine some tier 1 and tier 2 players.
- o Registration Update 254
 - Refund of 4v4 and 3v3 from 2019/20
 - Heather and Steve to double check to see if there are any outstanding refunds from last year
- Rostering
 - Outstanding Rostering Issues walk through
 - Dec.1 is generally the deadline
 - Parents to complete respect in sport and link it to their current player(s)
 - Return to play should be completed by all coaches and trainers
 - Each roster needs to have a defined goal tender
 - Stopping payments on injured players
 - Payments are amortized over the entire season (5 months)...not monthly payments. le...parents can not stop payment for a month and not participate.
- Teal Wood Baverstock proposal
 - LiveBarn:
 - Streaming service where cameras are installed inside the facility for outside viewing of activities. This will require sponsorship funding, PECMHA is not in a position to fund.
- Lisa Conley Promotion Request
 - Wants to create a skating program for young skaters. She wants to advertise her program with young skater groups via PECMHA members.
 - Executive decided to defer promotion requests for the time being
- Christmas 2 week "pause"
 - Families can gather without being in hockey social circle
 - If we decide to change bubbles and/or rework teams this gives an appropriate gap
 - Executive voted in favour of a 2 week pause over the holiday season (Dec.21-Jan.3) Last game played on Dec.20 and play will resume January 4th. ACTION: Steve to post on PECMHA website

- O U5 Incident:
 - Player taken off ice by paramedics, possibly a broken femur.
 - Executive decided to purchase a gift to send to player. ACTION: Ben to purchase gift and submit receipt
