2020/21 Hockey Season Planning

- All bench staff and executive need to do online return to play course
- To be completed by coaching staff prior to "Pre-skate" day October 3, 2020 ACTION ITEM: Steve to ensure
- Steve submitted PECMHA's return to play document to OMHA:
 - Second draft has been accepted
- As approved by OMHA, return to play guidelines include:
 - Maximum of 10 (9+1) skaters/team. Rostering based on birth year
 - Skaters who played rep last year will be tier 1,
 - LL players will be tier 2.
 - LL players who AP'd for Rep team last year can be called up to tier 1 as needed for rostering purposes.
 - Can roster 5 adults/team but only 1 coach and 1 trainer on the bench at any time
 - "League bubbles" consist of a maximum number of 50 players
 - Presently, PECMHA has not been approved to play outside PEC.
 - Facility guidelines:
 - Screening at the door and head counting is the responsibility of minor hockey:
 - Home team trainer to screen all entrants upon arrival to the arena including rostered team, coaching staff and family members
 - MB sports web has provided online form to be used in conjunction with iPads by home team trainer
 - One parent/guardian allowed in building per child
 - 50 people allowed in each building, different in other areas
 - Lisa Lindsay agrees that we will start with original plan of 50 in building at a time and amend as time progresses
 - Everyone must enter and exit through front doors of Wellington arena
 - Currently there will be no use of ½ ice boards
- Parent meeting will happen on "Pre-Skate" day Saturday October 3 or October 4 2020
- Executive to meet with coaches prior to parent meeting ACTION ITEM: Steve to set time
- Parents will be asked to arrive 30 minutes prior to their child's scheduled ice time. PECMHA executive members will then lay out the return to play plan for skaters and families

- Note on website today regarding returning to play on Saturday Oct.3/4 including options for 3 on 3 or 4 on 4 where the numbers support each ACTION ITEM: Steve to update website
 - 1.5hr time slots allotted per age group rosters. Times will be either Saturday Oct.3 or Sunday Oct.4
 - Steve is trying to find out if “bubbles” can change ACTION ITEM: Steve to follow up
 - AAA players can return to their home centre or stay with AAA development
- Ice time can start October 1, 2020

 - o If Picton opens, there will be much more ice time.
 - Heather, Ben and Jason meeting Wednesday September 30th to look at registrations and draft possible rosters ACTION ITEM: Heather, Ben and Jason
 - o Players must be registered before Sept.30
 - o No accommodation will be made for rostered teams given that there is no travel and reduced commitment from families
 - Coaching:
 - o No new coaches
 - o Hoping for grandfathering of past coaches with expired credentials
 Heather to work with OMHA to get past coaches grandfathered in. ACTION ITEM: Heather to check with OMHA
 - Bill for insurance received Sept.1
 - o Insurance companies recognizing reduced registration and adjusting costs appropriately
 - There will be no referees or time keepers
 - Coaches can make decisions to call up players from other “bubble teams” or work with opposing coach to move players around to create a game ACTION ITEM: Steve to pass along info to coaches
 - Need to buy hand sanitizer ACTION ITEM: Steve to designate this job
 - 15 min in dressing room before and after ice slot

- o No showers
- o Water bottles brought from home with water and name
- o Filling stations will be open
- o A list of updated rules will be sent to coaches
- ACTION ITEM: Obie to send email
- JR and Steve to look at old jerseys and get them cleaned for distribution early this week ACTION ITEM: Steve and JR
- PECMHA will order 4 sets of pinnies to add to current 4 sets for use on days when teams are combined. Coaches to look after getting them back to executive ACTION ITEM: Steve to order and pass message to coaches
- Pre-school not starting until after Thanksgiving
